AWESOME 4 WEEK GRAMMAR STUDY PROGRAM

Happy New Year everyone. But now it's back to work! I have devised a 4 week grammar study program using the books attached below. If you follow this, you'll be advanced for sure. Follow my instructions to the word and achieve greatness

Every day you will study a specific grammar point from a unit I have chosen and you will complete the exercises accompanying that unit. Your study will take place **over 5 days**. The additional **two days are for revision**: so you go over everything you have studied by:

1) Rereading the rules.

2) Rereading the exercises you have completed with checked answers.

3) (Most importantly) Make your own models based on the answers to really absorb the grammar (making the learning active: you'll remember better that way)

4) After the 4 weeks, you are free to practice specific grammar points from the other sources. When we do, for example, conditionals, we will only use one book otherwise you'll be overloaded.

This is the first out of two study programs. This one will deal with the broader areas of grammar. The second program next month will deal with smaller aspects!!!
